

## New Village Infrastructure Project

### Construction Begins

Northbridge Town Manager Ted Kozak recently announced the award of a \$990,000 contract to Sequoia Construction of Franklin, MA for the New Village Infrastructure Improvement Project. The project includes reconstruction of a portion of North Main Street, Crescent Street and Border Street. Work includes sidewalk replacement, drainage improvements and reconstruction and repaving of roadways within the project area.

“This project is being constructed using a combination of Chapter 90 State Highway Aid funds and a grant of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds from the State’s Community Development Block Grant Program.”, said Kozak. “This is a continuation of grant funded projects begun several years ago which include the Rockdale and Whitinsville Streetscape projects and the reconstruction of the lower portion of Border Street.”, Kozak added.

Work began early in July and is expected to continue through the end of November. To minimize disruptions to Balmer School, work will initially concentrate on Crescent and North Main Streets so that most work will be completed before classes resume in the fall.

The work will disrupt vehicle traffic in the project area and motorists are cautioned to drive with caution and observe the directions of traffic control officers.
