§ 201-24 . Noncriminal disposition. [Amended 10-24-2011; Effective 12-1-2011]

A. For purposes of noncriminal disposition under MGL C. 40, § 21D, and the Northbridge Code of Bylaws § 1-109A, any person who violates any regulation adopted by the Board of Health pursuant to MGL C. 111, § 31A, if not otherwise specified, shall be subject to a penalty in the amount of \$100 for the first offense, \$200 for the second offense, and \$300 for the third and all subsequent offenses in the same calendar year. Each day or portion thereof during which a violation continues shall constitute a separate offense, and each provision of the chapter, regulations or permit violated shall constitute a separate offense.
