Meeting Minutes January 9, 2013

Citizen's Forum

(248-584) Douglas Road (Map 3, A.P.O. Parcel 121)

Proposed delineation of wetlands using 50% or more wetland indicator plants, saturated / inundated conditions and hydric soil indicators. The applicant is Douglas Road Industrial Realty Trust represented by Andrews Survey & Engineering, Inc., PO Box 312, Uxbridge, MA 01569.

No representative was present for this Public Hearing. Ms. Kinney will contact the engineer again on how they wish to proceed.

(248-594) Lots 32 & 33 Shining Rock Drive (Shining Rock Golf Community) (Map 26, Parcels 129 & 130)

Proposed construction of two single-family dwellings located in the buffer zone of the Bordering Vegetated Wetland to the bank of an intermittent stream. The applicant is Norwood Cooperative Bank represented by Tunison Dias, Inc., 115 Main Street, Suite 2B, PO Box 73, North Easton, MA 02356.

Garret Tunison of Tunison Dias was present and explained that the work is proposed in the buffer zone. These are the last lots in this project that need to come before the Conservation Commission. The dwellings have been proposed as far away from the wetlands as possible. There will be roof drains for infiltration. Several logs will be placed near the wetland for wildlife to use as habitat. Lot 32 is 88 to 100 feet to the wetland area. On Lot 33, there will be a retaining wall and grading. A special condition is to have permanent wetland markers and can incorporate them into the retaining wall.

Motion made by Ms. Anderson and seconded by Ms. Peckham. The Conservation Commission voted 4-0 to close the Public Hearing.

Motion made by Mr. Arbuckle and seconded by Ms. Peckham. The Conservation Commission voted 4-0 to accept the plans entitled "Lot 32 & 33 Shining Rock Drive"

prepared by Tunison Dias, Inc. dated December 14, 2012 with a revision date of January 10, 2013 and with the special condition stated above.

Mr. Chagnon then took a few moments to explain the history of the project to the new members.

(248-210) 2223 Providence Road – Discuss Demolition of Garages Mr. Bobolair was not in attendance. Tabled to the next meeting.
