CMRPC has subcontracted the Center for Living & Working, Inc. (CLW) of Worcester, MA with James M. Mazik, AICP Consulting Services to assist with this effort. The first meeting was held on 2/10/22. Jonathan and Gary presented. They act as an independent third party to evaluate all the public buildings and make a transition plan to remove the architectural barriers. The town needs to pay \$5000 to match \$54675 grant for this effort. Bruce said that NB disability commission and MOD had all the evaluation and transaction plan done in 2010. Nothing has been changed since then. It would be a duplication effort. They should consult our commission first before they reach out to a

third party. There are several issues that need to be addressed, such as if a third party's prior approval by a town official and the superintendent of school before entering a school building. Bruce is very familiar with 521 CMR MAAB ADA law and is happy to assist in the evaluation and transition plan as a representative of NB Disability Commission.
