1. Call to order:

- The selectmen had approved NB ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan. - ❖ The guidance on ADA regulation for open space committee has been on hold because the new NB ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan. The new plan is different from the previous one. We need to go through it first and make sure we'd make right recommendation. Therefore we don't have anything to offer

now. Bruce said that there is no need to attend the open space public meeting this month until we'd have worked out the document. Jonathan suggested that we should ask open space committee for the proposal to see what projects they are going to do.

6. Member updates:

- ❖ Town manager Adam was not going to support Washa's project mainly because it is not related to disability issues. Jonathan asked Adam for clarification on what matters or issues that NB disability commission should and should not discuss, has not heard back from him. Washa agreed to withdraw the request.
- Bruce said that we need to follow up several projects such as senior center, school, and fire station. Jim has retired. Not sure who would be in charge, if there would be a replacement. Jonathan is going to follow up with Adam.
