The Board also will have the election conducted at a polling place and not exclusively by mail. It was decided to hold the election at the Northbridge Retirement Office on August 24, 2020. The election will be open from 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. and all retired members will be provided the option of voting in person or by mailing in an absentee ballot. All retirees will be mailed an absentee ballot.

Neil Vaidya made a motion to approve the Election Timetable for the Northbridge Retirement Board Election and the election choices of the Board.

The motion was seconded by George Murray.

The Board voted unanimously 4-0 to approve the Election Timetable for the Northbridge Retirement Board Election and the Election Choices.

Sharon Susienka made a motion to elect Scott L McGrath, the Board Administrator, as the Election Officer. The motion was seconded by Neil Vaidya.

The Board voted unanimously 4-0 to approve the election of Scott L McGrath as the Election Officer.
