 - o Crothers (NEW): Corner of Hill Street and Fowler Rd. (on Gary Colton's property.
 - o Mooradian (NEW): Fletcher Street (opposite Perron Bridge)
- Dick Trier said he would email this information to Jamie.

C. MONUMENT MAINTENANCE TO INCLUDE WWI ROCKDALE

- Jay noted previously that he would continue to reach out to Rosseel Contracting.
