The Board of Selectmen in Northbridge unanimously offers their strong support for the grant proposal from Family Continuity to establish Behavioral Health Clinics in the Northbridge High School. Northbridge, along with other towns in the Blackstone Valley, has witnessed an unfortunate series of suicides in the last few years. The Board is fully behind the effort to address mental health concerns in the schools to hopefully avoid future tragic outcomes.

About one month ago Craig Maxim and others in the working group presented their plan to the Board to provide behavior health services for high school students. The availability of in-school services will enable families who have difficulty transporting students to access mental health providers. The ease of meeting during the regular school day, the opportunity for psychiatric consultation and access for students with limited or no insurance will be tremendously helpful to our young citizens. Further, at times Police personnel have been called upon to assist students in crisis at the schools. Intervening before a crisis occurs is extremely beneficial for all those concerned.

The Northbridge Board of Selectmen fully and whole-heartedly endorses the efforts that FCP and others are pursuing to offer mental health services in the schools. By supporting our youth, we are creating future productive members of our society.
