Dear Board Members:

The Northbridge Safety Committee met on **Wednesday September 09, 2015** (8:00 a.m.) at the corner of Main Street & Lake St. and at Main St. & Water St. (west end). The following members were present: Chairman Gary Nestor (Fire Chief) Walter Warchol (Police Chief) James Shuris (DPW Director) Peter Bedigian, George Murray, Paul Halacy, and R. Gary Bechtholdt II (Town Planner).

The following members of the public were also in attendance: Eric Bazzett (Heritage Design) and Mr. Robert Cherrier (4 North Main Street - business owner).

Chairman Nestor called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

The following items were discussed Wednesday September 09, 2015 and are being forwarded to the Board of Selectmen as recommendations of the Northbridge Safety Committee:

Street Light Request - Ornamental Lighting: - Ms. Caryn Gagner, 22 Piedmont Street, Whitinsville, MA expressed concerns that almost all the decorative lights on Church Street, Linwood Ave. and Providence Road in Rockdale are out, especially in the area crosswalks and near the parks. DPW Director James Shuris made a recommendation that all the decorative light posts be numbered and tagged to make it easier to identify when needed. Mr. Shuris stated he is working with local electrician Thomas Kuik to trouble shoot and restore power to the affected lights. He will report back to the committee with his recommendations once this is done. A motion was made by Police Chief Walter Warchol and seconded by Peter Bedigian to have Mr. Shuris move forward with the project to make the necessary repairs to make the lights operational. The vote on this was unanimous.

<u>Douglas Road Speed Limit:</u> — Mr. Dennis Rice, Alternatives Unlimited, 54 Douglas Rd., expressed concerns with the speed limit on Douglas Road now that the road improvements have been completed to the bridge in Fletcher Street intersection. His concern was for the safety of the people who may be walking along or trying to cross the road. Mr. Rice states there have several close calls with his clients and/or employees since the roadwork has been completed. He has asked the Safety Committee to look into the possibility of reducing the speed limit to improve safety. The current speed limit along Douglas Road is 40 mph from Memorial Square to the Sutton town line. The committee has asked Mr. Shuris to look into the regulations as to whether this area can be classified as thickly settled. If so, the committee will ask to the Board to consider reducing the speed limit to 30 mph. The motion was made by George

Murray and seconded by Police Chief Walter Warchol for Mr. Shuris to look into the regulations and make his recommendations available at the next meeting of the Safety Committee meeting. **The vote on this was unanimous.**

Main Street Commercial Development: – Mr. Eric Bazzett, Heritage Design Group presented to the committee the site plan for a proposed commercial development in the area of Main Street and Lake Street as well as Main Street and the west end of Water Street. The proposal includes a 4,500 square foot retail store gasoline / diesel fuel station and a separate 4,000 square foot building to be used as a car wash. The committee met on site to get a better look at the proposal and see what impacts it would have on public safety. The location also allowed the committee to observe traffic congestion with the current traffic as well as school buses entering and exiting Lake Street. Some of the recommendations and concerns of the committee are;

- 1. Sightlines with the development being too close to the intersection of Lake Street. The concern was with a proposed exit for large trucks being opposite Lake Street where it intersects with Main St.
- 2. There are additional concerns with the curve along Main Street in this area and the possibility of large trucks having to cross the center line in order to exit the property. Mr. Bazzett stated all efforts were taken to design the exit to help prevent this from happening. It was noted that driver experience would play a big part in this as well.
- 3. Sightlines with at least one (1) utility pole obstructing the view of oncoming traffic while a driver is attempting to exit the property.
- 4. Concern of pedestrian crosswalk (location) & sidewalk with the increased traffic in the area due the commercial retail development.

Mr. Bazzett was asked if it was possible to redesign the site to accommodate the committee's concerns with sightlines and the proximity of the above locations. He stated he would consider the committee's recommendations and come back at a later date with any changes. He also stated the developers were in the process of having a traffic study conducted to see what impacts the proposed project will have on the area.

The committee took the discussion and observations made during the site visit under advisement and will look to offer its formal recommendation after the Applicant/Engineer presents the traffic study and consideration the items of concerns noted above.

Dear Board of Selectmen:

At its meeting of Tuesday, September 22, 2015, the Planning Board upon motion duly made and seconded voted unanimously (4-0) **TO RECOMMEND THE LAYOUT OF DEANE WAY.** In making its determination the Planning Board reviewed correspondence received from the Director of Public Works, the Board's consulting engineer (JH Engineering Group) and Town Counsel. Property owners within the subdivision and abutters to were invited and attended the Planning Board meeting of September 22, 2015.

In preparation for such consideration a site inspection was convened on Wednesday, July 22, 2015 with a follow-up inspection held Monday, September 21, 2015. Attendees, which included the Developer (John Barges), the Director of Public Works, Highway Superintendent and the Planning Board Chairman reviewed the subdivision and associated improvements including pavement, sidewalk, granite curbing, streetlights, and detention basin.

In addition attendees assessed the concerns that had impacted the adjacent property opposite the subdivision (67 Thurston Ave) during construction. The DPW Director and Developer concluded that the runoff was a result of the temporary removal of sections of granite-curbing and the relocation of a driveway for one of the house lots. DPW appears satisfied with the completion of the project and supports the acceptance of Deane Way at this time. The Planning Board is equally pleased and thanked the Developer for completing the subdivision.

Reference is made to Certification(s) received from the Registered Land Surveyor and the Registered Professional Engineer (Guerriere & Halnon, Inc.) indicating that all work, as required by the rules and regulations and the approved subdivision plan have been completed. Should you require additional information concerning this matter please contact the Planning Office.

West Nile Virus Confirmed in Mosquitoes from Northbridge

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) announced today that West Nile virus (WNV) has been detected in mosquitoes collected from Northbridge, Massachusetts.

WNV is most commonly transmitted to humans by the bite of an infected mosquito. The mosquitoes that carry this virus are common throughout the state, and are found in urban as well as more rural areas. While WNV can infect people of all ages, people over the age of 50 are at higher risk for severe infection.

By taking a few, common-sense precautions, people can help to protect themselves and their loved ones:

Avoid Mosquito Bites

- **Be Aware of Peak Mosquito Hours** The hours from dusk to dawn are peak biting times for many mosquitoes. Consider rescheduling outdoor activities that occur during evening or early morning. If you are outdoors at any time and notice mosquitoes around you, take steps to avoid being bitten by moving indoors, covering up and/or wearing repellant.
- Clothing Can Help reduce mosquito bites. Although it may be difficult to do when it's hot, wearing long-sleeves, long pants and socks when outdoors will help keep mosquitoes away from your skin.
- Apply Insect Repellent when you go outdoors. Use a repellent with DEET (N, N-diethyl-m-toluamide), permethrin, picaridin (KBR 3023), IR3535 or oil of lemon eucalyptus [p-methane 3, 8-diol (PMD)] according to the instructions on the product label. DEET products should not be used on infants under two months of age and should be used in concentrations of 30% or less on older children. Oil of lemon eucalyptus should not be used on children under three years of age. Permethrin products are intended for use on items such as clothing, shoes, bed nets and camping gear and should not be applied to skin.

Mosquito-Proof Your Home

- **Drain Standing Water** Many mosquitoes lay their eggs in standing water. Limit the number of places around your home for mosquitoes to breed by either draining or getting rid of items that hold water. Check rain gutters and drains. Empty any unused flowerpots and wading pools, and change water in birdbaths frequently.
- Install or Repair Screens Some mosquitoes like to come indoors. Keep them outside by having tightly-fitting screens on all of your windows and doors.



Immediate action includes the spraying of the affected area by CMMCP. This area includes the following streets or portions of: Ashmont Street, Church Street, Deane Way, Delray Gardens, Dudley Avenue, Edgemere Avenue, Gary Avenue, Henry Street, Highland Street, Hillside Drive, Hope Street, Laura Lane, Northern Avenue, Piedmont Street, Plummer Avenue, Plummer Park, Providence Road, Roy Street, Stoddard Avenue, Thomas Avenue, Thurston Avenue, and Wing Road.
