

The mission of the Northbridge Conservation Commission is to protect wetland resources through the use of regulations, management, education and collaboration with other governmental agencies. The main focus of the commission is the administration of the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Town of Northbridge Wetlands Protection Bylaw to control activity impact on the town's natural resources. We are concerned with the quality and quantity of surface and ground water, flood prevention, and protection of wetland-dependent wildlife. We promote the acquisition and protection of open space for conservation and recreation.
