VII. Discussion:

- a. Field Trip Approval- Student Council to Hyannis for State Student Council Conference
Carol Lourie requested approval for an overnight trip for the Student Council Members 2018. The trip will take place on March 7-9th, 2018 to Hyannis MA.
- b. School Calendar 2018-2019
Catherine Stickney shared the school calendar for 2018-2019 with the Committee. There were a few adjustments for parent conferences, and we have reached out to surrounding districts for the PD days.
- c. FY 2019 Budget
Melissa Walker stated that she and Cathy had met with the Town Manager yesterday to review the budget information and discuss the next steps. We are expecting that we will receive some information around February 8th or 9th on our proposed appropriation.
- d. Before and After School Programming
Melissa Walker discussed the before and after school programming for the district. Melissa stated that we have had an RFP for the program in 2015. When we did the RFP for that contract, we did a one-year contract with two one-year options to renew. Our options are to look to renew for the 3rd year or put out another RFP to solicit more proposals. Cathy recommended that we put out an RFP verses renewing for the 3rd year.
- e. Transfer of Funds to Cover Chemical Waste Disposal at NHS/NMS
Melissa Walker requested that the School Committee approve a transfer of \$9,215.00 from the Athletic Field Supplies line item to the Contracted Services line item.
- f. School Building Committee Update
Joseph Strazzulla stated that he, Cathy, Melissa, OPM, and the Design Team are going to meet with the MSBA and have the facilities review. We will be more involved with the MSBA in the next few months. The next forum will take place in March. We do still have to vote to appropriate the funds to pay for our share.
- g. High School Principal Search

Catherine Stickney stated that they have created the timeline for the position. We have posted the position and collected applications. This week we are looking for individuals looking to participate in selection/interview process. The search committee will meet to look over applications on February 7th.
