Springboard- Extended Learning Day Programs

Kim Jennings, VP of Partnership Development, discussed Springboard Education to the Committee. Kim stated that Springboard exists to make an authentic difference in out-of-school time programming and students' lives. Doctoral-Level educators dedicated to out-of-school time developed the Springboard Model. This model is a new model of learning

and fun. It is a STEAM and Literacy focused Curriculum that is project and outcome based.

 Michael Gauthier and Aaron Katz discussed the changes to the Program of Studies for the 2016-2017 school year.
- Northbridge High School- Graduation Rate and Drop-out Rate
 Michael Gauthier discussed the NHS Graduation and Drop-Out summary. The
 Graduation Rate for 2014-2015 was 90.40%.

c. FY 17 Budget

Melissa Walker stated that in accordance with our budget timeline, we are submitting the draft Superintendent's recommended budget for Fiscal Year 17. The budget for FY 17 is of about 4.3%. Our contribution from the town in the form of appropriation is of about \$425,000.00. Of that \$425,000.00, \$46,000 is coming from Chapter 70.

d. FY2016 Budget Transfers Across Line Items Melissa Walker stated that a motion was needed to transfer \$31,846.78 from salary line items and \$17,870.80 from the athletic transportation line items to Out of District Tuition line items.
