

Please be advised that in 1987, Louis and Janice Dykstra, formally of 21-23 Haringa Avenue, applied for a loan through the Town of Northbridge's Mass. Small Cities Program for the purpose of making housing improvements. The loan was approved, and the proceeds were dispersed to Louis and Janice with the stipulation that full repayment of the loan would be required upon sale of the home or a change of ownership deed. Town Manager's Report for the Period of April 26, 2021 – May 7, 2021

1. Key Meetings Attended:

- Monday, April 26, 2021 Attended the Board of Selectmen Meeting via Zoom.
- Tuesday, April 27, 2021 Held CBA negotiations with the Police Association.
- Wednesday, April 28, 2021 Held CBA negotiations with the Firefighters Association.
- Thursday, April 29, 2021 Met with the three (3) Police Chief candidates to explain the results and provide feedback from the interview panel.
- <u>Friday, April 30, 2021</u> Held a Department Managers Meeting to prepare for the Spring Annual Town Meeting.
- <u>Friday, April 30, 2021</u> Conference Call with MIIA regarding FY2022 General Insurance Renewal.
- <u>Friday, April 30, 2021</u> Conference Call with Town Counsel Doneski regarding the motions for the Spring Annual Town Meeting.
- Monday, May 3, 2021 Conference call with FinCom Chair to prepare for Town Meeting.
- <u>Tuesday, May 4, 2021</u> Attended the Spring Annual Town Meeting.
- Wednesday, May 5, 2021 Conference Calls with the Balmer Project OPM and Building Committee Chair regarding fence easements.
- Wednesday, May 5, 2021 Conference Call with Town Counsel regarding collective bargaining.
- Thursday, May 6, 2021 Held CBA negotiations with the Northbridge Police Association.
- 2. <u>Balmer School Building Project</u>: Project construction by Fontaine Brothers continues with precautionary measures in place per State construction guidelines for construction projects moving forward during the pandemic. The Town Manager is working with the OPM to secure temporary fence construction access from abutters. The OPM is working on punch lists as the project will approach substantial completion over the next couple months. The project timeline is on target for opening this Fall.
- 3. <u>Lasell Field Turf Project</u>: The project is essentially complete except for several punch-list items that we are working to get scheduled (loam and seed).
- 4. <u>Fire Station Project</u>: The BPCC has hired CHA as the OPM and TGAS as the architect for the project. The design team has begun meeting with the Town and prepping for the baseline data for the design which includes the field survey and soil testing. A meeting with the BPCC will be held in the upcoming weeks.
- 5. **FY2022 Budget & Town Meeting Warrant:** The Spring Annual Town Meeting was held this past Tuesday, May 4, 2021. All but one of the articles were approved (Article 21 passed over) and the Town departments will now begin to plan for capital improvements as well as preparing financial documentation for the upcoming year.
- 6. <u>Town Offices Re-Opening</u>: Town Hall offices are to be opened to the public this coming Monday, May 10, 2021 with limited hours of 10-2 Monday through Thursday and 10-12 on Fridays. In-person Board meetings are expected to begin in June.
