 - Rebecca is interested in hiring part-time help for summer-Charlie asked about what the requirements would be for employment-they would need to be able to cover the vacations of the staff and to help with children's programming-covered under the town if we still have enough money or state aid if we need it

- Ann mentioned that the Golden Rule in the Trustees Handbook notes that the collection is at the sole discretion of the librarian and if the librarian director chooses to add this to the collection then she consider adding The Village Voice or some other left leaning paper to balance the collection
- Rebecca mentioned her three reasons for not including the paper

- Charlie's research indicated that no public libraries in MA carry this paper
- Adam asked questions to John about his feelings regarding why this paper needs to be in there
- Adam explained points regarding how the money is spent in the library regarding the collection
